Heather is a non-practicing member of the Law Society of BC.

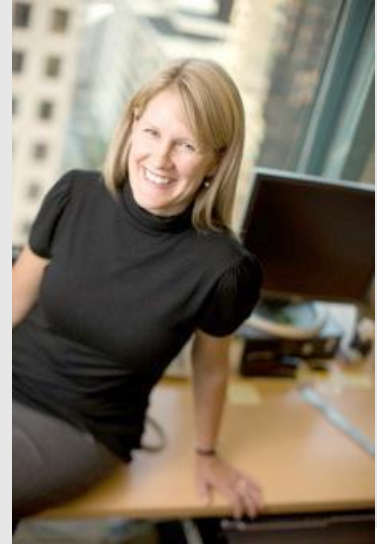
